Welcome to the Charlotte's Web Scavenger Hunt in Downtown Waynesville. All answers can be found by walking down Main Street from the corner of Franklin and Main Street and crossing the street at the Veterans Memorial Park, and back to the starting point.

Good luck, have fun, and look closely to find answers. Return this to The Mary L. Cook Public Library no later than **August 7** to be entered for a chance to win a lovely prize. Just drop this paper in our **book drop**, located by the front door.

- 1. Fern Arable and Wilbur are taking a stroll down Main Street in Waynesviile. Starting from the north end and walking down the right-side sidewalk, they come upon a large home that is **Stubbs Conner Funeral Home**. This building was a school before it became a funeral home. Wilbur is happy to see lanterns in front. He hopes these will keep the ghosts away. How many lanterns do you see around the steps closest to the sidewalk?
- 2. Wilbur and Fern continue walking down the sidewalk only to stop at **Waynesville Candy Shop**. Fern notices the candy display in the windows. Looking at these make her so hungry. How many candies on sticks can you count in the windows?
- 3. As they continue down the sidewalk they see Charlotte is hanging out under the table in front of the **Butter Churn Café**. Fern is still hungry. Maybe some ice cream will help. What kind of ice cream is sold here?
- 4. Templeton, the rat, is waiting in front of **Waynesville Antique Mall**. He is looking up at Willie Wonka. Can you spy Willie Wonka? Do you know the name of the book he is a character in?
- 5. The group continues down the street but stop in front of the **Village Salvage**. They can't help but stare at the animal created from license plates. What animal is this?
- 6. Fern's brother, Avery, joins the group on the porch of the **Hammel House**. How many tables are on the porch?

- 7. The group continues on down the street and crosses, carefully, at the **Waynesville Veteran's Memorial Park** (bottom of South Street). Charlotte loves history. When was this park dedicated?
- 8. The group leaves the park and turns right, heading back up Main Street. Templeton smells food! The group follow Templeton as he turns into **Scioto Square**. Templeton's nose directs them to the steps of the **Stonehouse Tavern**. What color are the umbrellas on the patio?
- 9. Everyone turns and heads back towards Main St. but Charlotte must stop to look at all the signs on the porch of a **Touch of Heaven**. Charlotte loves words, she is a logophile. How many signs with words do you see on the porch?
- 10. Back on Main Street, Templeton insists they stop in front of the **Village Family Restaurant**. His nose is in the air and he sniffs and sniffs. What is the special of the day?
- 11. The next stop is **Bentino's Pizza.** Templeton wants to look for dropped pepperoni. Wilbur counts the tables in front of the restaurant. How many are there?
- 12. Everyone continues on up Main Street. The group is getting tired so, they stop at the **Gazebo**. Charlotte notices a memorial for an important person. Whose name is on the memorial?
- 13. After a short rest everyone is ready to move on. In front of a shop that seems to sell pet clothes, they spy a cement dog. What does the dog have in its mouth?
- 14. Continuing up Main Street, the group decided they need a bit of shade to rest. They all stop on the porch of the **Chamber of Commerce**. Charlotte sees words on rocks in the garden, in front of the office. What do the words say?
- 15. Rested and ready to move on the group stops to admire the **Funkey House**, big green house with fence. Fern says it looks like a mansion. What letter do you see on the front doors?

16. Finally, the group reaches the corner of Franklin and Main Streets. Up ahead Templeton smells something good! **Pat's Gas** must have treats for the group. Do they sell ice cream inside?
